- Journeys of our expansion coordinator and national director. God has led all; for success of DMPD.

- Main leaders of student led-movement had a retreat. Aug 2 -8, to plan the university year and to prepare for Pamoja conference. There were 17. God is highly exalted.

Requests:

- We ask God to provide us with all (human, material, and financial) resources we need for a short-term project of 10 students in Niamey in November.
- Pray for the Parakou Project, the second most important university town. We pray that God glorifies His name by beginning a movement there.
- We pray for the development of resources and of all kind of added capacities for the fulfillment of *squadron of life*.

BURKINA FASO

CHAD

We praise God:

- For His protection during flooding, Aug 27-29. There were no victims among the staff or associate staff families, in spite of damage thorough the city.
- Ten Arabophone students from Abeche University and three staff members took part in English courses organized by BUEA University in Cameroun throughout Aug. These students have been interested in Jesus' life during their training.
- For mobilization of Christians in Chad to all weekly prayer network and prayer watches, concerning the Great Commission, as result of different seminars organized in the country.
- As results of the "Faith Bore Through Listening" project, there were many commitments and many lives changed. We work in partnership with Biblical Alliance in the Moundou area located in the South of the country.
- For peace in Chad for five months. Some rebel groups are joining the Republic.

We pray:

- For participation of 10 student leaders at Pamoja in December. They need to raise funds for the travel and participation. We pray that they come back with a greater commitment, a life renewed by the Holy Spirit to minister among students.
- We are expecting 500 students from universities and higher schools at Sinai Camp 6, scheduled for April 2010 in Moundou. We pray to have God's wisdom in order to impact lives of our students' disciples. We pray for the material and financial needs.
- That by the end of university training, our disciples will dwell close to God, to the ministry, and continue to influence their circles.
- For mobilization and participation of Christian executives in training and seminars scheduled for 2010, in order to equip them to impact the professional world with their behavior and the gospel. That God will work in their hearts to make them available and that He changes their lives through this program which will take place in N'djamena, Doba, and Sarh. Pray for financial requirements.
- That true disciples come among students, executives and churches members in order to launch a spiritual movement for fulfillment of the Great Commission among students, leaders and to support ministry through the three strategies.
- For love, unity and truth among Christians in our country. Lack of love and a rejected feeling are obstacles to God's reign. That God helps ecclesiastical leaders who struggle with a lack of love and the rejected feeling. They have to look after change, for themselves and for all Christians.
- For God's wisdom and direction to reinforce partnerships with churches, in order to go on in the JESUS Film Ministry.
- For financial requirements for 2010 – (a) activities of the three strategies (\$35,000); (b) survival needs of the staff; (c) administrative fees for our national office; funds to acquire our own place for the national office (\$85,000); and (d) care for staff members who are ill.

- We pray that God leads us toward available people, willing to support the ministry financially.

CONGO (BRAZZAVILLE)

We praise God for:

- Presidential elections that took place in peace, without violence in spite of tension between the power and opposition parties.
- The presence of all staff members at DMPD training, although some were ill.
- The beginning of development of material and financial resources.
- Cohesion and unity among the staff. May God be glorified for the quality of work being done in the three movements, in spite of the limited numbers of staff members.

Requests:

- We pray that DMPD training, which is in process, will help us to collect partners in order to bring out national ministry and also to change the low conditions of life of staff members.
- For achievement of our investment projects especially – (a) production of a Christian loincloth; (b) exploitation of the Christian bookshop; (c) purchase of the seat of our national direction; and (d) developing of the ministry's grounds.
- For recruitment of new staff members in our ministry.
- For recovery of staff members who suffer from chronic diseases (renal failure, hypertension, sinusitis, etc.).
- For development of partnerships with churches who cling to quasi evangelization and to “show evangelization.”

COTE D'IVOIRE (IVORY COAST)

- Pray for preparations for PAMOJA AFRICA to be hosted here in December.
- For the 1,500 students leaders who will be equipped to build “movements everywhere.”

GABON

Praise to the lord for:

- His health, His support and His protection for staff members after the strongly contested presidential elections.
- The results of actions on ground during first semester of this year.
- For enabling our national director and Rev. Landry to take part in the AFREG 2 conference in Kenya.

Let us continue to pray for:

- The obtainment of legal entity of our movement in Gabon.

- Return of freedom, security and peace in our country after the elections.
- Discipleship that leads to recruitment of three to six additional staff members, of steadfast calling, for the training of 2009-2010, and meet Campus Crusade for Christ standards.
- Participation of at least 120 people in Pamoja in Yamoussoukro, Côte d'Ivoire in December.
- DMPD training, which will take place from Sept. 20 to Oct. 20. For God's protection, health and for understanding and putting concepts into practice by the participants.
- HomeBuilders we trained, that they may evangelize professionals by stabilizing their homes. We pray couples involved in this work catch the vision and become models for others.
- We pray that new political authorities do not oppose themselves to gospel proclamation.

GUINEA

We give thanks to God for:

- His protection and provision.
- Staff commitment and the opportunities he gives them to build "movements everywhere" through operational strategies in Guinea.
- His support during the "Dakieba" project in Lola (800 km to Conakry) in August.
- The success of staff children on their exams.

Requests:

- We pray for DMPD. The slope has become too slippery because of inefficiency of maintaining plans, stopping of Blitz and political and economic crises in the country.
- Many disciples are at the end of their academic training. We ask God to give us new, committed disciples in order to build movements in universities already reached.
- Expansion Movement scheduled training for all members of partnering groups in Conakry. For success of this training and the involvement of Christ's body to help us evangelize Conakry.
- Our country suffers from political and economical crises. We pray for God to manifest His presence and glory during this transitional period.
- Ask God to put His hand on the president and to lead him and his government to perform their reformation plan and to organize credible and clear elections.

MALI

Praise:

- We praise God for good health of the staff, associated staff and partners.
- For the training of new missionaries and their commitment in God's work.
- Glory to the Lord for our national plan "Green TATA for Christ."

Requests:

- We pray that missionaries will be able to face up to challenges in their assigned countries. That they integrate themselves easily and they become skilled manpower for national offices.

That this model will be understood and followed, so that all countries organize themselves to send missionaries.

- That all aspects of “Green TATA for Christ” be understood and financed so that we can reverse little by little certain destructive trends here. We pray to have means to reach non-reached people and to build churches for them.
- That each staff member in Mali gets 100% of his support, so that God’s work be done freely.
- For the construction of our national office. Gold and money belong to God, so we ask Him to provide us with the means for this specific need.

SENEGAL

Praise:

- We praise God for political stability of our country and during school year 2008-2009.
- Eighteen American students were in Senegal to help the university ministry: 316 people have been exposed to the gospel, 21 made decisions and 13 were strengthened by blue booklet.
- We praise God for four young missionaries coming from DRC. By the end of trans-cultural training, they will minister for three years in the university. We praise God for five students coming from North Carolina in October 2009 to bring out university ministry.

Requests:

- We pray to God for Congolese and American missionaries - for adaptation to this new life and God’s protection. That God fills them with the Holy Spirit to reach, train and send Christocentric, multiplying disciples.
- That God motivates students to take part in Pamoja. That He leads these 15 students toward people available to help raise funds for their travel. May all who take part in Pamoja be changed, fully committed to God’s work in Senegal or anywhere.
- Ask God to support financially our national direction. Subsidies are not enough to meet rent, electricity, water fees, etc.
