## A Church in Every Village

Northern India is one percent Christian. But in Haryana, an area of 24 million people adjacent to Dehli that is historically resistant to the gospel, God is moving.

The *JESUS* film was shown many times in India as part of the New Life 2000 campaign. Yet as follow-up lagged, Deepak Lal of Northern India began praying for something more significant to occur in his state of Haryana. Collaborating with a couple church pastors, a vision of a church in every village emerged.

Deepak and partners first surveyed the 20 districts of their state, sub-dividing the districts into 120 “blocks” (each block consisting of a mere 200,000 people and 100 villages). They then called pastors of some existing churches to prayer walk the entire state (120 blocks, 6600 villages). Through prayer, the significant church partnerships that now exist among pastors of more than

64 different denominations began to take form.

A second survey found that only 35 blocks had churches—making a church in every block a more measurable intermediate goal. The training of others suited for the pastorate emerged as the next hurdle.

Utilizing many of our familiar ISOT principles, a Foundations for Christian Leadership training program launched into preparing fresh converts willing to commit to a minimum of five years in the pastorate. Nearly 500 lay pastors (tentmakers) have been trained.

The training of lay pastors emphasizes three items:

- Evangelism and discipleship - the need to form 2-3 cell groups of new believers.
- Principles of church leadership training.
- Then two candidates from the

cell group or the new church (once the small groups merged) receiving the same training they had just come through.

In 2007, Deepak and partnering church pastors of more than 60 denominations celebrated the answer to their prayer - God's achievement of a church in every block. Today, there are more than 1,800 new church plants in Haryana. And in united prayer, they continue to march toward the goal of a church in every village!
