

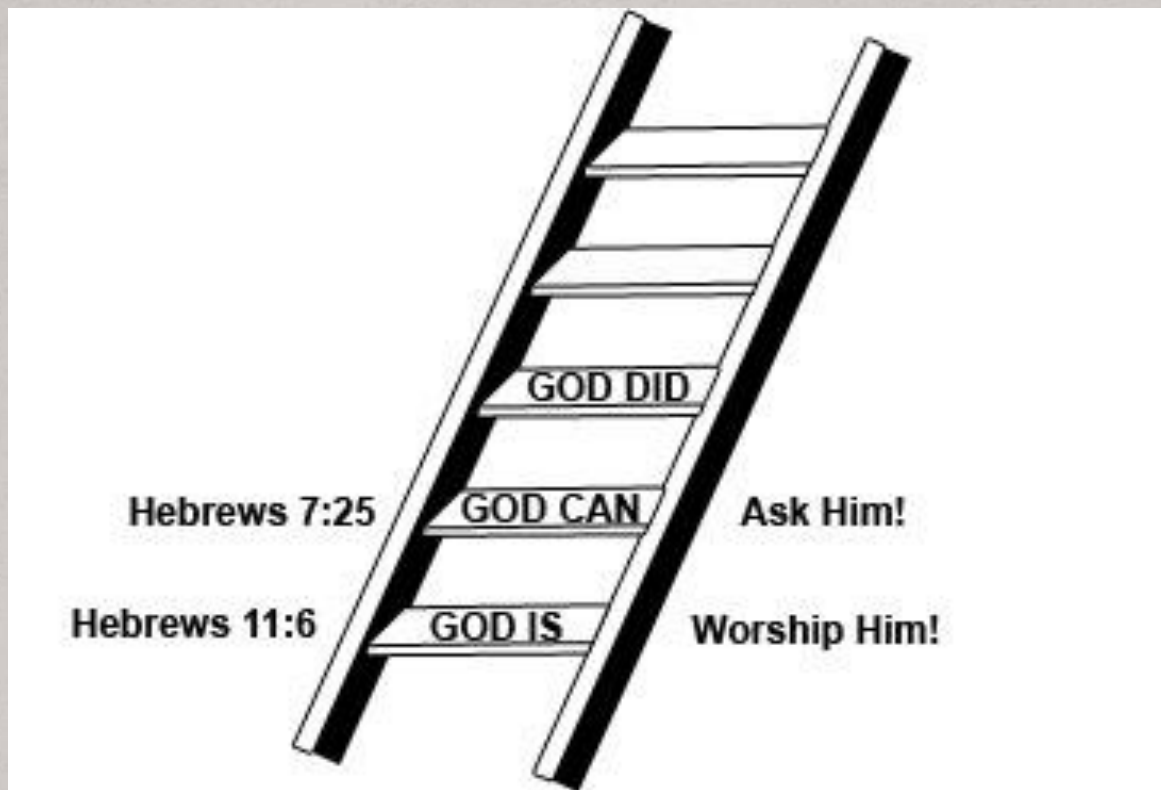

# Biblical Foundation:

“For we who have believed do enter that rest...the works were finished from the foundation of the world.”

Hebrews 4:3 NKJV™ (emphasis added)

# **The Purpose of This Session**

is to develop thanksgiving for all of the answers God has already prepared for us.

# Introduction:

Our Biblical Foundation in Hebrews 4:3 assures us that:

1. Difficult prayer requests do not perplex God.  
“For with God nothing will be impossible.”

Luke 1:37 NKJV™

2. He [**prepared**] His answers for us  
from the time of creation.

“...the works were finished from  
the foundation of the world.”

Hebrews 4:3b NKJV™

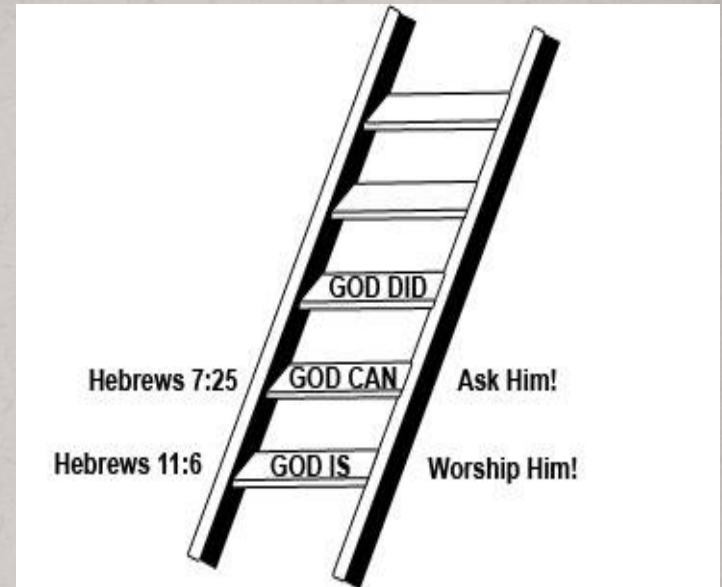
3. He is not limited by time. He exists in one eternal “now.”

“Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever You had formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, You are God.”

Psalm 90:2 NKJV™

# A. Basic Truth: GOD DID!

1. God has already **[accomplished]** all that He is going to do.
2. Answers to believing prayers are [ready] for you to receive.



“Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.”

3. Plant your faith in God, not in your ability  
to believe.

## B. Scripture: Ephesians 1:3

1. Answers to our prayers have already been supplied to us by Christ Jesus.

“Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ.”

Ephesians 1:3 NKJV™ (emphasis added)

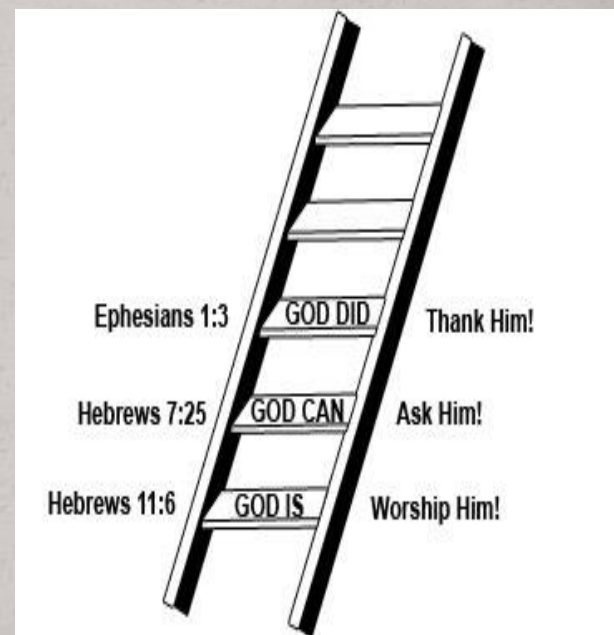
2. This Scripture declares that His provision involves the entire [heavenly] realm --- a reservoir far greater than earthly resources.
3. Praying is partaking of answers that are available now.
4. Our faith grows by knowing that answers are waiting in heaven.

## C. Prayer Action: Thank Him.

### 1. Thank God for already [providing] your answers.

“But as it is written: ‘Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him.’ But God has revealed them to us through His Spirit. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God.”

1 Corinthians 2:9,10 NKJV™



## 2. Praise Him for His works in the past.

“All Your works shall praise You, O Lord, and Your saints shall bless You. They shall speak of the glory of Your kingdom, and talk of Your power, to make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of His kingdom.”

Psalm 145:10-12 NKJV™

### 3. Thank Him for His future guaranteed answers.

“Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.”

Ephesians 3:20,21 NKJV™
