ARGENTINA

Praises:

- For the participation of 230 students at our annual Training Camp. During the eight days, they were envisioned and equipped to build on-campus movements.
- For the Mapuche Project, where 60 professionals actively participated for two weeks, providing medical care, different kinds of donations and built a church in an indigenous community.

BOLIVIA

Praises:

- Pray for our new program of staff development, which has recently been restructured according to our culture and needs. Please pray for this now that we are getting five new staff members who are ready for their training.
- We pray for new staff members and for the health and well-being of our current staff - for their spiritual, physical, social and emotional well-being.

CHILE

Praises:

- We praise God because we have had a successful national leadership transition. The atmosphere in the Chilean Ministry is pleasant, and we are all aligned to the team work and goals for the next three years.
- We are thankful to God because in Concepción there are 130 students who have expressed an interest in talking to someone about a personal relationship with God.
- Praise the Lord for the three new staff members and another still raising support. We thank God for the people He is raising up.

Requests:

- Ask God to give us creativity and plenty of contacts to raise support for the national ministry.

- For the Project to Spain in January 2010. We are sending eight students who will be sharing about the love of Jesus for a month. May God provide their finances and growth.

COLUMBIA

Praises:
